Christa L. Filipowicz is currently the Supervisor for the Town of Clarkson. Prior to her appointment in January 2019 she served on the Town Board and was the chair of the Planning Board.

Christa has focused much of her energy on Comprehensive Planning. She witnessed the explosive growth in in town and the vulnerabilities that went with it. She professionally guided residents and developers through this unprecedented time and volunteered to take on the large task of updating the Clarkson Comprehensive Plan with a bipartisan committee.

Most recently she volunteered to update the Town's website so that factual information and news is readily accessible. She also joined with the Town of Sweden to create and administer an

online survey for the Sweden-Clarkson Recreation Center. The results provided guidance for the goals of the community center and recreational services.

A fiscal conservative Christa has long been a proponent for educating our residents about the town budgets, tax rates and assessments. She seeks to reduce costs through shared services including the Seymour Library, Sweden Clarkson Recreation Center, and inter-municipal agreements.

Christa believes in less government, lower taxes, and encourages more direct involvement by the residents. She is an advocate for voter registration and encourages younger members of our community to make full use of this privilege.

A long time resident of Clarkson, Christa is retired from a career in Marketing in higher education serving both Rochester Institute of Technology and SUNY Brockport. Over the years her community volunteer activities have included the SUNY Brockport Alumni Association– Board of Directors and President; LIFE Liberty Partnerships program for at-risk youth– Advisory Board; Brockport High School Booster clubs for hockey and football; youth baseball, BISCO Board– Brockport Arts Festival, and the Lakeside Hemlock Twig. Christa was honored to be inducted into the SUNY Brockport's Hall of Heritage in 2003.
